2023 HRD Tuition and Fee Waiver Guidelines

Per N.C. General Statutes (G.S. 115D-5(b)(13)), individuals enrolling in courses offered through the Human Resources Development (HRD) Program may be granted a waiver of registration fees if they meet one of four criteria:

- i. Are unemployed;
- ii. Have received notification of pending layoff;
- iii. Are working and are eligible for the federal earned income tax credit;
- iv. Are working and earning wages at or below two hundred percent (200%) of the federal poverty guidelines.
