Following are reference citation examples in APA style for frequently used source types.

BOOK:

Beck, C.A. J., & Sales, B.D. (2001). *Family mediation: Facts, myths, and future prospects*. Washington, DC: American Psychological Association.

EDITED BOOK:

Gibbs, J.T., & Huang, L.N. (Eds.). (1991). *Children of color: Psychological interventions with minority youth*. San Francisco: Jossey-Bass.

- Note: For a book with just one author and an editor as well, list the editor in parentheses after the title.

BOOK, NO AUTHOR OR EDITOR:

Merriam-Webster's collegiate dictionary (10th ed.). (1993). Springfield, MA: Merriam-Webster.

JOURNAL ARTICLE:

Mellers, B.A. (2000). Choice and the relative pleasure of consequences. *Psychological Bulletin*, 126, 910-924.

MAGAZINE ARTICLE:

Kandel, E.R. & Squire, L.R. (2000, November 10). Neuroscience: Breaking down scientific barriers to the study of brain mind. *Science*, 290, 1113-1120.

NEWSPAPER ARTICLE:

Schwartz, J. (1993, September 30). Obesity affects economic, social status. *The Washington Post*, pp. A1, A4.

NEWSPAPER ARTICLE, NO AUTHOR:

New drug appears to sharply cut risk of death from heart failure.
(1993, July 15). *The Washington Post*, p. A12.

- Use n.d. (no date) ONLY when a publication date is not available. This should be very rare.
