He/She does hereby acknowledge to know and understand that such training, exercises, and observations could expose him/her to risk of injury to self and/or property as the result of accident, upset, or other casualty to, with or by the participation or observation of such class.

The undersigned, by these presents, for him/her and heirs, assigns and representatives, forever release, give up, surrender and quitclaim any and all rights which he/she may have against the institution of Nash Community College including all its officers, directors, trustees, affiliates, partners, representatives, agents, employees, and students to recover from Nash Community College and individuals noted above, or agency, money, damages, or any other thing of value as a result of any accident, incident, or happening growing out of or in any way connected with the class noted above.

The undersigned DOES HEREBY ASSUME THE RISKS described above and WAIVES any rights he/she or his/her heirs, assigns and successors may have to sue Nash Community College, its officers, directors, trustees, affiliates, partners, representatives, agents, employees, and students, and/or otherwise claim relief for losses to his/her person or property arising out of the risks herein before described, whether or not due to the negligence of instructors, staff, volunteers, personnel, and/or students and HOLD HARMLESS AND RELEASE said parties from any liability to himself/herself or his/her heirs, assigns, and successors for any such losses.

Nash Community College’s policy for a “Concealed Weapon on-campus”: ALL HANDGUNS MUST BE:

1. Unloaded
2. In a closed container (hard or soft handgun case)
3. Locked with a disabling gun lock (trigger or breach). If you do not have a gun lock, a local law enforcement agency MAY be able to provide one for free OR purchase one from a retail store that sales gun supplies.
4. Handgun and ammunition must be transported in SEPARATE containers.
DO NOT transport the handgun and ammunition in the same case or container.

HANDGUN TRAINING SAFETY RULES

1. An approved Nash Community College (NCC) Firearms Instructor/Staff will oversee compliance of all rules/regulations/policies/procedures in the firing range.
2. Students must comply with all instructions from the Instructor/Staff.
3. No loaded handgun shall be brought onto NCC property, into the range or placed in the range lockers. Handguns must pass through the clearing station. Handguns are to be loaded at the firing line only.
4. Before being allowed to use the firing range, all students must demonstrate safe handgun handling techniques to the Instructor/Staff.
5. Before leaving the firing range, Instructor/Staff will check handguns to ensure all ammunition has been removed (ie handguns will be clear, safe and secured by Instructor/Staff).
6. DO NOT leave the firing line with a loaded or jammed handgun. If a misfire or other malfunction occurs, keep the handgun pointed downrange and signal the Instructor/Staff. Place the handgun on the bench pointed downrange, and obtain Instructor/Staff assistance only.
7. Always point the handgun in a safe direction (downrange). Notify Instructor/Staff if leaving the firing line. Leave handgun on the firing line, unloaded with the action open and the muzzle pointed downrange.
8. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
9. Always keep the handgun unloaded until ready to use.
10. All handguns, rifles and shotguns are subject to approval by the Instructor/Staff. Any unsafe or unserviceable firearm will be excluded from the range.
11. No spectators allowed in the firing range.
12. Eye protection and earplugs must be worn AT ALL TIMES and are provided by the College, or students may bring their own.
13. Only authorized targets are permitted on the range.
14. All ammunition is subject to inspection and approval. Allowable calibers are: Handguns, .22 rimfire through .45 caliber. Rifles that are chambered for .22 through .223/5.56. NO PISTOLS THAT ARE CHAMBERED FOR RIFLE CARTRIDGES. NO ALUMINUM OR STEEL CASED AMMUNITION. NO STEEL CORE AMMUNITIONS ARE ALLOWED.
Shotguns: All gauges, buckshot, slugs and birdshot are permissible. Shotguns are to be fired from the shoulder only. NO STEEL SHOT IS ALLOWED. SHOTGUNS WITH PISTOL GRIP ONLY ARE PROHIBITED.
15. Nash Community College and its Instructor/Staff shall not be held liable for any damages incurred from use of ammunition. Ammunition issues must be resolved with the manufacturer.
16. No one is allowed on the range under the influence of alcohol or any controlled/uncontrolled substance.
17. Any horse play, misbehavior, or improper conduct/gestures will result in IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL FROM THE PREMISES.
18. Report any unsafe behavior/conduct to the Instructor/Staff immediately.
19. Any violation of range safety rules may result in IMMEDIATE REPRIMAND and POSSIBLE DISMISSAL.

Nash Community College reserves the right to refuse use of the range to any person for any reason at the sole discretion of an Instructor/Staff or any NCC official or employee.

NASH COMMUNITY COLLEGE RULES FOR PARTICIPATING IN A HANDGUN TRAINING COURSE

ALL HANDGUNS MUST BE:

5. Unloaded
6. In a closed container (hard or soft handgun case)
7. Locked with a disabling gun lock (trigger or breach). If you do not have a gun lock, a local law enforcement agency MAY be able to provide one for free OR purchase one from a retail store that sales gun supplies.
8. Handgun and ammunition must be transported in SEPARATE containers.
DO NOT transport the handgun and ammunition in the same case or container.

Upon arrival at the Nash Community College Continuing Education Building, students must park at the Handgun Firing Range, located on the backside of the Continuing Education (CE) Building, in the designated parking spaces marked "Range Parking". (see attached Campus Map)

Upon arrival at the classroom / firing range, the student will:

1. Report to the lobby of the firing range with unloaded and locked handgun still in the closed container and ammunition in a separate container and await further instructions from the Instructor/Staff.
2. With Instructor/Staff assistance, each student will place the unloaded and locked handgun and ammunition into a handgun locker, provided within the firing range.
3. Follow every detail of instruction given by the Instructor/Staff, then report to the classroom and take a seat.
