

NURSE AIDE LEVEL II TRADITIONAL AND HYBRID

REQUIREMENTS:

1. A high school diploma or GED equivalency.
2. Verification of successful completion of an approved Nurse Aide Level I program at a state approved facility (community college or Allied Health program in high school) and current listing on the NC Nurse Aide I registry with **no** substantiated finding of resident abuse, resident neglect or misappropriation of resident or facility property in a Nursing Facility.
3. **Preregister & prepay, first come first serve starting on the first day of preregistration at 8:00 am** in the Continuing Education suite on the second floor of the Continuing Education Building at Nash Community College. To register you must bring a copy of your high school diploma or equivalency, your completion certificate from a state approved program and proof of current listing on the NC NAI registry with **no** substantiated finding of resident abuse, resident neglect or misappropriation of resident or facility property in a Nursing Facility. (You may obtain proof of current listing at www.ncnar.org) Registration cost is \$186.25.
4. **Purchase books & supplies:**
 - *Advanced Skills for Health Care Providers* 2nd edition by Barbara Acello
 - *NAII Packet* [The NAII Packet is only available at the Nash Community College campus (book) store]
 - *NAII supply kit* [The NAII supply kit is only available at the Nash Community College campus (book) store]

The cost of books and supplies is approximately \$ 170.00.00 (cost is subject to change without notice). The textbook, packet and supply kit will be needed on the first day of class.

5. On the first day of class you will need to present documentation of a negative TB Skin test (If you have ever had a positive reaction to a TB skin test please contact the program coordinator for further instructions)
6. During flu season documentation of current influenza (flu) vaccine must be presented before you are eligible for clinical.

OTHER SUPPLIES: Uniforms needed for clinical training (specifics will be discussed in class), watch with a second hand, folder for handouts, note paper. You will not need uniforms until the beginning of clinical. Some clinical facilities may require the student to obtain a criminal background check or drug screen.

NA II APPLICATION FEE: \$24.00 payable to the North Carolina Board of Nursing in the form of a money order or Visa or MasterCard information. The fee is sent in with the NA II application to the state and is due on the last day of class.

Note: All cost and fees are subject to change without notice.

CLASS INFORMATION:

This course consists of 160 hours of instruction (this includes classroom and clinical) and generally runs for 14 weeks.

CLASS SIZE: The class is limited to 10 students.
