

NURSE AIDE LEVEL I TRADITIONAL AND HYBRID

REQUIREMENTS

1. **Reading and math TABE tests are required with a score of 8th grade level on both portions.** This requirement is waived for students with an Associate Degree or higher or a silver level CRC. A copy of a college transcript or a documentation of silver level CRC is required for waiver. You must have a referral to take the TABE. The referral can be obtained from anyone in the Continuing Education Suite located on the second floor of the Continuing Education Building at Nash Community College. Once you have your referral you will be directed to the location on campus for the TABE. There is no appointment necessary and no charge for the TABE. The Continuing Education Suite is open M – Th. 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. and Friday 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. or 1 p.m. depending on the season. Hours may be verified by calling 252-451-8216.

2. **Preregister & prepay, first come first serve starting on the first day of preregistration at 8:00 am** in the Continuing Education Building on the second floor at the Continuing Education Suite. You must bring a copy of your TABE test scores, college transcript or CRC if the placement tests are being waived. Registration cost is \$186.25.

The cost of books and supplies is approximately \$ 130.00 (cost is subject to change without notice). Renting the textbook may reduce the cost. The Nash Community College campus store can assist you with purchasing or renting textbooks. The textbook, packet and kit will be needed on the first day of class.

4. On the first day of class you will need to present:

- Documentation of a negative TB Skin test (If you have ever had a positive reaction to a TB skin test please contact the program coordinator for further instructions)
- Valid state issued driver's license or state issued identification with picture and signature
- Social security card

5. **Skills Competency Test Fee: \$101.00**, implemented by the NC Nurse Aide I Registry, administered by and payable to NACES after successful completion of the course. This fee is due the last day of class.

OTHER SUPPLIES: Uniforms needed for clinical training (specifics will be discussed in class), watch with a second hand, folder for handouts, note paper. You will not need uniforms until the beginning or clinical.

CLASS INFORMATION:

This course consists of 160 hours of instruction (this includes classroom and clinical) and generally runs for 13 – 14 weeks. For hybrid classes a portion of the 160 hours consist of online assignments.

CLASS SIZE: The classes are limited to 10 - 15 students per class depending on the section.
