

NAII Refresher (Competency Assessment)

The NAII Refresher (Competency Assessment) course is designed to allow NAII's who have let their NAII listing expire get back on the NAII registry without having to complete an entire NAII course. To be eligible for the NAII refresher at Nash Community applicants must have received their NAI training through a state approved program and must be currently on the NAI registry with no substantiated findings of abuse, neglect, or misappropriation of funds on the DHSR Nurse Aide Registry.

Applicants must also meet one of the requirements below and must be able to present documentation that one of these requirements was met:

1. The NAII must have been eligible for renewal of NAII Listing prior to the listing expiration.
 - The NAII must have worked at least eight hour for compensation during the past 24 months performing nursing care activities under the supervision of a Registered Nurse
 - The NAII must have no substantiated findings of abuse, neglect, or misappropriation of funds on the DHSR Nurse Aide Registry
2. The NAII has had a continuous period of 24 months during which nursing care activities were not performed for monetary compensation, but patient care activities were performed for compensation.
