

MEDICATION AIDE REQUIREMENTS

1. A high school diploma or GED equivalency.
2. Verification of successful completion of an approved Nurse Aide Level I program at a state approved facility (community college or Allied Health program in high school)
3. Documentation of current listing on the NC Nurse Aide I registry with **no** substantiated finding of resident abuse, resident neglect or misappropriation of resident or facility property in a Nursing Facility.
4. **Preregister & prepay, first come first serve starting on the first day of preregistration at 8:00 am in the Continuing Education Building on the second floor at the Continuing Education Suite.** You must bring verification of successful completion of an approved Nurse Aide Level I program and of your current listing on the NC Nurse Aide I registry with **no** substantiated finding of resident abuse, resident neglect or misappropriation of resident or facility property in a Nursing Facility. Registration cost is \$76.00
5. **Purchase books & supplies:**
The Medication Aide textbook
Medication Aide packet (The Medication Aide Packet is only available at the Nash Community College bookstore)

The textbook and packet cost approximately \$20.00 (cost is subject to change without notice). The textbook and packet will be needed on the first day of class.
6. **Skills Competency Test Fee: \$55.00**, implemented by the Medication Aide Registry, administered by and payable to the PearsonVue after successful completion of the course.

CLASS INFORMATION

The class consists of 24 hours of class time with **100% attendance required per N.C Board of Nursing regulation.**

CLASS SIZE: The class is limited to 10 students.
